  - The wastewater system can't handle any more organic leading, (meaning we don't have enough bugs). Flow is okay and meets standards.
  - o Fox farm charts are not accurate and shouldn't be used, apart from Compliance 301.
  - O Jellystone is requesting more land, but do they want more water?

- O Development criteria AR-1 we can run it it just has a crack in the casing.
- O Currently it is not cost effective to drill the Laramie-Fox Hills.
