



**TOWN OF LARKSPUR
ORDINANCE NO. 3.114**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 3.107 ARTICLE III
SECTION B AND ADOPTING FEMA FLOOD MAP DATED MARCH 16, 2016.**

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds it is necessary to adopt an emergency ordinance for the immediate preservation and protection of public health, welfare and property, specifically it must adopt the map approved by this ordinance on or before March 16, 2016 in order for its residents to obtain or maintain flood protection; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to update its Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study Map to the March 16, 2016 version in order to comply with FEMA requirements.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Ordinance 3.107 § III shall be amended by adding the underlined language to read in its entirety as follows:

**“SECTION B. BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD
AREA**

The Special Flood Hazard Areas identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in a scientific and engineering report entitled, "The Flood Insurance Study for Douglas County, Colorado and Incorporated Areas," dated March 16, 2016, with accompanying Flood Insurance Rate Maps and/or Flood Boundary-Floodway Maps (FIRM and/or FBFM) and any revisions thereto are hereby adopted by reference and attached hereto and declared to be a part of this ordinance. These Special Flood Hazard Areas identified by the FIS and attendant mapping are the minimum area of applicability of this ordinance and may be supplemented by studies designated and approved by the Town Counsel of Larkspur, Colorado. The Floodplain Administrator shall keep a copy of the Flood Insurance Study (FIS), DFIRMs, FIRMs and/or FBFMs on file and available for public inspection.”

2. **Publication and Effective Date.** This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Larkspur for the reasons described above, and therefore, shall become effective immediately as an emergency ordinance upon adoption by the Town Council.





