

ORDINANCE NO. 3.39

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION OF ZONING, ANNEXATION, PLANNING,
SUBDIVISION OR BUILDING ORDINANCES OF THE
TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR,
COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Purpose. This ordinance is adopted for the purpose of promoting the health, safety, convenience, order, prosperity and general welfare of the present and future habitants of Larkspur, Colorado.


SECTION 2. Penalty for Violations. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of the annexation, zoning, planning, subdivision, or building ordinances of the Town of Larkspur, contained within Chapters 2 or 3 of the Town of Larkspur Ordinances, shall constitute a petty offense, punishable by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that such violation continues shall be considered and be punished as a separate offense.

Introduced as an ordinance at a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado, on the 1st day of October, 1986, and passed by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and ordered published.
