

ORDINANCE NO. 3.93

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 3.69 REGARDING SEPARATED GRADE CROSSINGS ALONG RAILROAD TRACKS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS

WHEREAS, on March 2, 1999, the Larkspur Town Council adopted Ordinance 3.69, which disallowed separated grade crossings at railroad tracks within the limits of the Town; and

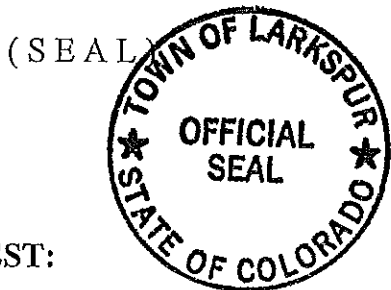
WHEREAS, the Larkspur Town Council has determined that separated grade crossings at railroad tracks within the Town will improve the circulation of vehicles, including emergency vehicles, within the Town; and

WHEREAS such crossings are in the best interests of the Town and will preserve the health, safety and welfare of the Town, its citizens, and visitors.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:


Ordinance 3.69 is hereby repealed.
