

ORDINANCE NO. 7.07

AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE AN AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX ON REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR FOR WATER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Larkspur Home Rule Charter, the Colorado Revised Statutes 31-15-302 (c), and the Constitution of the State of Colorado, the Town of Larkspur has the authority to impose an ad valorem property tax on the real property located within the Town of Larkspur if the same is approved by a vote of the electors of the Town, and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 1982, notice was published in the Douglas County News-Press of an upcoming election in which the following question would be considered: "Shall the Town of Larkspur adopt an Ordinance to impose an ad valorem property tax of 10 mills on real property within the Town of Larkspur for the purpose of acquiring water and water rights for the Town of Larkspur and for the provision of water acquisition, treatment, storage, and distribution facilities?" and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 1982, an election was held in which the above-cited question was voted on by the voters and

WHEREAS, at the election held on April 6, 1982, the voters approved the adoption of the Ordinance to impose such ad valorem property tax.

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Larkspur:

That an ad valorem property tax of 10 mills shall be imposed on all real property within the Town of Larkspur for the purpose of acquiring water and water rights for the Town of Larkspur and for the provision of water acquisition, treatment, storage, and distribution facilities.

Done at a regular meeting of the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Larkspur on the 12th day of May, 1982. Approved by a vote of 5 for and 2 against and ordered published.
