ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE SUMS OF MONEY

ORDINANCE NO. 108

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE VARIOUS FUNDS AND SPENDING AGENCIES, IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSE AS SET FORTH BELOW, FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, FOR THE 1983 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on October 13th, 1982, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has make provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget, and;


WHEREAS, it is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, so as not to impair the operations of the Town;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the following sums are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for purposes stated:

General Fund		Utility Fund
Current Operating Expenses	\$ <u>40,800</u>	<u>9,657</u>
Capital Outlay	\$ <u>4,200</u>	<u>3,140</u>
Debt Service	\$ <u>0</u>	<u>4,515</u>
Total General Fund	\$ <u>45,000</u>	<u>17,312</u>
