

ORDINANCE # 712

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE

An Ordinance appropriating additional sums of money to defray expenses in excess of amounts budgeted for the Town of Larkspur, Colorado.

WHEREAS, The Town of Larkspur has received \$400,000.00 in Grant and Loan funds from the Colorado Water Conservation Board and the Colorado Department of Local Affairs for the construction of a water supply system. These revenues were not assured at the time of the adoption of the budget.

And, WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town's Utility Fund.

Now, therefore, be it Ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado;

Section 1. That the 1983 appropriation for the Utility Fund is hereby increased from \$17,312.00 to \$417,312.00 for the following purpose: Construction of a water supply system.
