

ORDINANCE # 713

SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE

An Ordinance appropriating additional sums of money to defray expenses in excess of amounts budgeted for the Town of Larkspur, Colorado.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has received \$25,000.00 in Sales and Admission tax; Development and Investment fees; and Interest Income to be used for Attorney fees, office expenses, police equipment, road repairs and miscellaneous items. These revenues were not assured at the time of the adoption of the budget.

And, WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town's General Fund.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado;

Section 1. That the 1983 appropriation for the General Fund is hereby increased from \$45,000.00 to \$70,000.00 for the following purpose: Attorney fees, office expenses, police equipment, road repairs, and miscellaneous items.
