

TOWN OF LARKSPUR

ORDINANCE No. 7<sup>16</sup>

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has received \$40,000.00 in Sales and Admission tax; Development and Investment Fees; and Interest Income. These revenues were not assured at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, this income is to be used for Attorney fees, office expenses, road and bridge repairs and miscellaneous items; and

WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town of Larkspur's General Fund;


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1

That the 1984 appropriation for the General Fund is hereby increased from \$68,243 to \$108,243 for the following purposes: Attorney Fees, Office Expenses, Road and Bridge repairs, and miscellaneous items.
