

TOWN OF LARKSPUR

ORDINANCE NO. 7.17

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 7.09
PERTAINING TO AN ADMISSIONS TAX

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR,
COLORADO, as follows:

SECTION I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to increase revenues which are derived from collection of the admissions tax imposed by Ordinance 7.09 upon certain events as defined therein held within the corporate limits of the Town of Larkspur, the revenue raised thereby to be used for the payment of the expenses of operating and improving the Town and its facilities.

SECTION II.

This Ordinance hereby repeals and supersedes Section 5.2 of Ordinance No. 7.09, passed on the 20th day of April, 1983.

SECTION III.


Section 5.2 of Ordinance No. 7.09 is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following substituted in its stead:

5.2. The amount of the tax hereby levied is 4¢ of the price of each admission; provided that a tax derived from calculations resulting in a fraction of a cent being a part of the tax shall be increased or rounded to the next whole cent. If a block of admissions is sold to a single purchaser at a bulk rate, the tax shall be computed on the bulk rate in such cases instead of on individual admissions, provided that none of the tickets in the block are resold.


SECTION IV. - SEVERABILITY

Should any portion of this Ordinance be determined to be unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, that portion shall be determined to be severable and the balance of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
