

TOWN OF LARKSPUR
ORDINANCE NO. 7.30

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has received Sewer and Water User Fees, Interest, and other income in the amount of \$5,000. These revenues were not assured at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, this income is to be used for utilities, maintenance, and other operating expenses; and

WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town of Larkspur's Utility Fund;


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1


