

TOWN OF LARKSPUR
ORDINANCE NO. 7.23

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES
IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has received Annexation and Zoning Fees, and
other income in the amount of \$48,100.00. These revenues were not assured
at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, this income is to be used for administrative, engineering, legal
and other general operating expenses; and

WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town of Larkspur's General Fund;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO,
AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1

That the 1986 appropriation for the General Fund is hereby increased from
\$106,900.00 to \$155,000.00 for the following purposes: administrative,
engineering, legal, and other general operating expenses.

and 0 against and ordered published.


