

ORDINANCE NO. 1.02

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICE
TO THE MAYOR, BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE TOWN CLERK
OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR

An Ordinance to provide compensation for service for the Mayor, Members of the Board of Trustees, and the Town Clerk to become effective upon the qualification of those persons elected in the April 6, 1982, General Municipal Election or appointed thereafter;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR,
COLORADO:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to allow for the compensation of the Mayor, Board of Trustees, and Town Clerk for services rendered to the Town. Section 3.05 of the Larkspur Home Rule Charter and 31-4-304 of the Colorado Revised Statutes 1973 authorize such compensation.

SECTION 2. MAYOR

The Mayor of the Town of Larkspur shall be compensated the amount of \$700.00 per year. This amount is due and payable annually, commencing May 1, 1982.

SECTION 3. TRUSTEES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Each Trustee of the Board of Trustees shall be compensated the amount of \$150.00 per year. This amount is due and payable annually, commencing May 1, 1982.

SECTION 4. TOWN CLERK

The Town Clerk for the Town of Larkspur who has been duly appointed and is acting in accordance with Section 4.03 of the Larkspur Home Rule Charter shall be compensated \$400.00 per year. This amount is due and payable annually, commencing May 1, 1982.

SECTION 5. OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES

Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to limit in any way the reimbursement of actual and necessary out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the Mayor, a member of the Board of Trustees, or Town Clerk in the performance of the duties of their

respective offices.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

The above-prescribed compensation shall commence for the Mayor and Trustees of the Board of Trustees who are elected on April 6, 1982, and the Town Clerk who is appointed by the Mayor thereafter.

Introduced at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Larkspur on the 10th day of February, 1982. Passed by a vote of 6 for and 1 against and ordered published.
