

ORDINANCE NO. 1.08

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION TO THE MAYOR  
AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO  
(This Ordinance hereby repeals and supercedes  
Ordinance No. 1.04 passed and adopted on April 7, 1986  
and Ordinance No. 1.02 passed and adopted on February 10, 1982)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur,  
Colorado, as follows:

1. This Ordinance hereby repeals and supercedes Ordinance  
No. 1.04, which was passed and adopted on April 7, 1986.

2. This Ordinance hereby repeals and supercedes Ordinance  
No. 1.02, which was passed and adopted on February 10, 1982.

3. The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide  
compensation to the Mayor and Town Council for services rendered  
to the Town. This Ordinance is authorized by and enacted in  
accordance with Section 3.05 of the Larkspur Home Rule Charter.

4. Each Mayor of the Town of Larkspur who is elected, re-  
elected, or appointed subsequent to the effective date of this  
Ordinance shall be compensated in the amount of \$1,200.00 per  
annum, which amount shall be paid monthly.

5. Any Mayor currently in office, who was elected or  
appointed prior to the effective date of this ordinance, shall be  
compensated in the amount of \$1,200.00 per year until such time,  
if any, that he or she is re-elected. Any unpaid portion of this  
amount shall be paid on March 31, 1992.

6. Each Town Council member who is elected, re-elected, or  
appointed subsequent to the enactment of this Ordinance, shall be  
compensated in the amount of \$300.00 per annum. This amount is  
due and payable annually on March 31 of each year.

7. Any Town Council member currently in office, who was  
elected or appointed prior to the effective date of this  
ordinance, shall be compensated in the amount of \$300.00 per  
year until such time, if any, that he or she is re-elected. Any  
unpaid portion of this amount shall be paid on March 31, 1992.

8. Reimbursement for Expenses. Nothing in this Ordinance  
shall be construed to limit, in any manner, the reimbursement of  
actual and necessary expenses incurred by the Mayor or members of  
the Town Council in the performance of the duties of their  
respective offices.

9. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after  
it is posted, in accordance with Section 3.20 of the Town  
Charter.

Introduced as an ordinance at a regular meeting of the Town  
Council of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado, on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of  
March, 1992, and passed by a vote of 5 for 1  
against and 0 abstentions.
