AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING DISTRICT MAP OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO

(FINAL PUD ORDINANCE - COLORADO RENAISSANCE FESTIVAL: P-AREA)

WHEREAS, on the Ahh day of February, 1980, a Petition was filed with the Town Clerk praying for an amendment to the Zoning District Map of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado, as hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the said Petition was forwarded by the Town

Clerk to the Town Planning Commission and Board of Trustees;

and

WHEREAS, the Town Planning Commission and Board of
Trustees has held a public hearing, following notice duly
made and published, into the matters contained in said Petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, as follows:

That the zoning classification of the lands described upon Exhibit "A", consisting of one page attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby changed from zoning classification A-1 (Agriculture and Forest District) as said land was zoned by the County of Douglas prior to its annexation to the Town of Larkspur to zoning classification PUD (Planned Unit Development District).

## Permitted Uses

- A. Motor Vehicle Parking (during festival period only)
  - B. Access Roads
- C. Entry and Exit Signs and Facades (during festival period only) (Subject to regulations set forth on the approved preliminary site plan)

  Completion Schedule

Eight years after the effective date of this ordinance.

Additional Terms and Provisions

The above described parcel is subject to those additional terms and provisions contained in paragraphs 3, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14 Town of Larkspur, Ordinance No. 3.05, passed March 5, 1980.

That the document entitled "Final Site Plan for a P.U.D. Rezoning of a Part of Section 33, T.9.S., Range 67 W. of the 6th P.M., Town of Larkspur, Douglas County, Colorado," dated February 27, 1980, and on file with the Town Clerk of the Town of Larkspur, is hereinto incorporated by this reference and all markings and notations thereon are made a part hereof as if fully set forth herein.

## Safety Clause

By reason of the fact that the Town is in need of additional ground water resources and that this ordinance will promote the acquisition of additional ground water resources; it is hereby declared that an emergency exists, and this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and that it shall take effect upon adoption and compliance with the provisions of C.R.S. 1973, Section 31-16-104, as amended.

Introduced as an Ordinance at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado, on the 5th day of March, 1980, and passed by a vote of 4 for and 1 against, and ordered published.
