

TOWN OF LARKSPUR
ORDINANCE NO. 4.01

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE LARKSPUR VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT
AS THE EMERGENCY RESPONSE AUTHORITY FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIAL
INCIDENTS WITHIN THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur desires to designate an Emergency
Response Authority to be responsible for taking initial emergency
action necessary to minimize the effects of hazardous material
incidents within the corporate limits of the Town of Larkspur.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, as follows:

That pursuant to C.R.S. 1973, 29-22-102, as ammended, Larkspur
Volunteer Fire Department is hereby designated as the Emergency
Response Authority for hazardous material incidents within the
Town of Larkspur. That the Larkspur Volunteer Fire Department
shall provide emergency response to hazardous material incidents
by taking initial emergency action necessary to minimize the
effects of a hazardous material incident and by exercising
continuing supervisory authority over all further efforts to
eliminate the threat of immediate and irreparable harm to the
environment or the public health and safety.


THAT, if a hazardous material incident occurs on private property,
the owner or operator thereof, may undertake the emergency response
to such hazardous material incident and shall notify and
coordinate such response with the Larkspur Volunteer Fire
Department. If the owner or operator does not undertake such
emergency response or if in the judgement of the Larkspur Volunteer
Fire Department there exists an imminent danger to the public
health and safety beyond such property, the Larkspur Volunteer
Fire Department shall be responsible for the emergency response
to such hazardous material incident as provided in this ordinance.
THAT, an emergency exists and this ordinance is necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health and safety and that it shall
take effect upon adoption and publication in compliance with the

provisions of C.R.S. 1973, 31-16-104, as amended.

Introduced as an Ordinance at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado, on the 8th day of April, 1981, and passed by a vote of 5 for and 0 against, and ordered published.
