ORDINANCE NO. 4.08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4.05,
AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A MUNICIPAL COURT
SYSTEM FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur deems it in the best interest of the Town to establish a municipal court and to appoint a Municipal Court Judge, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that suitable court facilities cannot be provided within the Town of Larkspur and that the court facilities of the Town of Castle Rock are within reasonable proximity of the Town of Larkspur; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur has determined that the establishment of a municipal court and the appointment of a Municipal Court Judge will promote the health, safety, prosperity, security and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Larkspur.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR COLORADO as follows:

SECTION I

Ordinance No. 4.05 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II - MUNICIPAL COURT CREATED

A municipal court in and for the Town of Larkspur is hereby created and established, pursuant to and governed by the provisions of Article 10, Title 13, C.R.S. 1973, as amended.

SECTION III - JURISDICTION, POWERS AND PROCEDURES OF COURT

The municipal court shall have original jurisdiction of all cases arising under the code and other ordinances of the Town of Larkspur with full power to punish violators thereof by the imposition of such fines and penalties as are prescribed by ordinance or court rule.

The procedures of the court shall be in accordance with the Municipal Court Rules of Procedure as promulgated by the Colorado Supreme Court.

SECTION IV - INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

The Town Council hereby authorizes the execution of an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado to provide for municipal court facilities and for the administration thereof.

SECTION V - MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE

1. Term of Office - The Municipal Court Judge is hereby appointed to serve at the pleasure of the Town Council.

2. Compensation - The compensation of the Municipal Court Judge shall not exceed the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per year.

3. Removal - The Town Council may remove the Municipal Court Judge from office at any time, for any reason, by the enactment of an ordinance revoking his appointment.


4. Selection of Municipal Court Judges - The Municipal Court Judge shall be selected from interested applicants by a majority vote of the Town Council.

5. Qualifications - The Municipal Court Judge shall be an attorney at law admitted to practice in the State of Colorado.


6. Howard Allsback is hereby appointed as the Municipal Court Judge for the Town of Larkspur.
