ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE CONNECTION OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR TO THE STATE'S SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the State has constructed sewage treatment facilities for the Larkspur Rest Area, in the vicinity of I-25 and Larkspur, with a capacity greater than that which is expected from the Rest Area Usage; and

WHEREAS, the State and Town by mutual agreement of their duly authorized representatives, deem it to be in the best interests of the people of the State of Colorado and the Town to permit the Town to connect to the State's sewage plant;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1

The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the connection of the Town of Larkspur with a sewage treatment facility owned by the State of Colorado in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Larkspur by providing them with the use of an efficient sewage disposal and treatment facility.

Section 2

The Town of Larkspur, pursuant to its powers authorized by Sections 31-15-101(c) and 31-15-302(d), C.R.S. 1973, as amended, shall enter into contract with the State of Colorado to allow the Town of Larkspur to connect to the sewage treatment facilities located in the vicinity of I-25 and Larkspur. The contract shall set forth all the rights and duties of the respective parties in regard to the use and maintenance of said sewage treatment facility, and shall be executed by duly authorized representatives for each party.

In accordance with Sections 31-16-103, 31-16-104, and 31-16-105, C.R.S. 1973, as amended, this ordinance was introduced, read, passed and ordered published by a special meeting of the

Board of Trustees on the 6th day of August, 1980,
by a vote of 6 to 0.
