AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING  
LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION FEES

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has incurred and shall continue to incur actual and necessary expenses for the purpose of evaluating applications for liquor licenses, and;

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 12-47-135 (3a) authorizes local licensing authorities to set application fees to cover the actual and necessary expenses incurred to process such licenses,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, as follows:


ARTICLE I.

General Provisions


1.01 Each liquor license application submitted to the Town of Larkspur shall be accompanied by the following fees:

1. For a new license - \$350.00
2. For a transfer of location or ownership - \$150.00
3. For a renewal of license - \$50.00
