

ORDINANCE NO. 6.10

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 6.08 AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6.05 PERTAINING TO BUSINESS LICENSE FEES IN THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO (This Ordinance hereby repeals and supersedes Ordinance 6.08, passed and adopted on October 11, 1989, and repeals and supersedes Sections 5 and 6 of Ordinance No. 6.05, passed on the 7th day of May, 1986)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 6.08 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 6.05, is hereby repealed in its entirety and the following substituted in its stead:

Section 5. FEES. Every person, firm or corporation required to be licensed by the provisions of this Ordinance No. 6.05, shall pay an annual license fee. For each calendar year the license fee shall be \$30.00 if paid after March 31 of the effective calendar year. However, the fee shall be \$15.00 if paid on or before March 31 of the effective calendar year. No license shall be issued or renewed unless all license fees have been paid in full to the Town and all sales, use and admission taxes have been paid to the Town.

Section 3. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 6.05, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
