(This Ordinance hereby amends Section 1.3.6
of Ordinance No. 6.09 passed on the 11th day
October, 1989)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur,
Colorado as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.3.6 License Fee, of Ordinance No. 6.09
is hereby amended by adding Section 1.3.6.1, as follows:

1.3.6.1 Temporary License and Fee. An
applicant may apply for a Temporary License in
accordance with the License shall be Five Dollars
(\$5.00). If an applicant otherwise qualifies for
a license under this Ordinance, the Town Clerk may
grant a Temporary License which shall be valid for
a single calendar day. The Town Clerk shall
clearly identify the date for which the license is
valid on the face of the license. An applicant
may obtain up to seven (7) Temporary Licenses
during any calendar year.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days
after it is posted, in accordance with Section 3.20 of the Town
Charter.

Introduced as an Ordinance at a Special meeting of the Town
Council of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado, on the 21st day of
May, 1991, and passed by a vote of 5 (5) FOR, none (0)
AGAINST, and no (0) ABSTENTIONS.

clearly identify the date for which the license is valid on
the face of the license. An applicant may obtain up to
seven (7) Temporary Licenses during any calendar year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days
after it is posted, in accordance with Section 3.20 of the Town
Charter.
