ORDINANCE NO. ~~27~~ 3.67

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF OFFICAL SIGNS AND PROHIBITING PARKING ALONG CERTAIN SECTIONS OF SPRUCE MOUNTAIN ROAD WITHIN THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, on April 14, 1982, the Town adopted Ordinance No. 4.03, regulating traffic and adopting by reference the 1977 Edition of the Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities; and

WHEREAS, Section 12-2 of the 1977 Edition of the Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities provides that no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in any manner in violation of the provisions contained on an official sign which restricts or prohibits stopping, standing or parking, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device or except for the purpose of loading or unloading passengers; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public safety and welfare to prohibit parking along certain sections of Spruce Mountain Road within the Town.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado, as follows:

Section 1: In accordance with the provisions of Section 12-2 of the 1977 Edition of the Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities, and as an amendment to Schedule VIII thereof, no person shall park a vehicle upon the following described parts of Spruce Mountain Road located within the limits of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado:

On the East side of Spruce Mountain Road from the South end of the Buss/Cardenas Annexation south to the South end of the Larkspur Town Park; and

On the West side of Spruce Mountain Road from the South end of Petunia Park south to one hundred feet (100') south of the South side of Perry Park Road.

Section 2: The Town is authorized to place official signs prohibiting parking along the portions of Spruce Mountain Road described herein.

Section 4: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect


