

TOWN OF LARKSPUR  
Ordinance No. 3.69

AN ORDINANCE DISALLOWING A SEPARATED GRADE CROSSING TO BE BUILT AT THE RAILROAD TRACKS (NORTH AND SOUTH BOUND), ANYWHERE WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE, THROUGH THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO as follows:

**Section 1.** A separated grade crossing at the railroad tracks, north and south bound, shall not be allowed to be built anywhere within the town limits of Larkspur, Colorado.

**Section 2.** If a majority of all votes cast at the election on the measure shall be for the measure, the measure and the related ordinance shall be deemed to have passed.

**Section 3.** The Town Council and the Town Clerk shall take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this ordinance.

**Section 4.** If a section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

**Section 5.** This ordinance is necessary to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Town, and covers matters of local concern.

**Section 6.** This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after a favorable vote by the Town of Larkspur, Colorado registered voters.

**Section 7.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen days after final publication, as provided by Section 5.11 of the Charter.

Passed, adopted and approved this 2nd day of March, 1999, by a majority vote of the citizens of Larkspur, Colorado.
