

ORDINANCE NO. 3.85

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE 3.66 BY INCREASING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD, THE ROAD AND BRIDGE ADVISORY BOARD, THE SEWER AND WATER ADVISORY BOARD, AND THE PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION ADVISORY BOARD TO THE LARKSPUR TOWN COUNCIL FROM THREE MEMBERS TO FIVE MEMBERS EACH

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur previously enacted Ordinance No. 3.66 establishing a Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, a Road and Bridge Advisory Board, a Sewer and Water Advisory Board, and a Personnel and Procedures Advisory Board to the Town Council of Larkspur; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of Ordinance 3.66 provided that each of the aforementioned advisory boards was to be comprised of three (3) members and two (2) associate or alternate members, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that there is a need for greater participation on the Advisory Boards and therefore desires to increase the number of members of such Advisory Boards for three (3) to five (5).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 7 of Ordinance 3.66 shall be revised in its entirety to read as follows:
 7. **Membership.** Membership of each Advisory Board shall consist of five (5) members. Members of the Advisory Boards will be appointed by the Town Council. Two (2) associate or alternate members may be appointed by Council.
2. **Severability.** If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Town Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

3. Repeal. Existing ordinances or parts of ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this ordinance are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.
