

**ORDINANCE NO. 3.87**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT  
ADVISORY BOARD TO THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR,  
COLORADO**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance 3.66 the Larkspur Town Council has previously created various advisory boards to the Town Council, including a Parks and Recreation Advisory Board, a Road and Bridge Advisory Board, a Sewer and Water Advisory Board, and a Personnel and Administration Advisory Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has determined that in order to encourage economic development, growth and vitality within the Town of Larkspur, it is in the interest of the public welfare and the financial well being of the Town and its citizens and businesses to establish an Economic Development Advisory Board for the purposes set forth below.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. An Economic Development Advisory Board is hereby established.
2. The Town Council will inform the Economic Development Advisory Board as to the availability of funds for expenditure on matters pertaining to economic development within the Town of Larkspur.
3. The powers of the Economic Development Advisory Board shall be advisory only.
4. The purposes of the Economic Development Advisory Board shall be to:
  - a. Advise the Town Council on recommendations concerning economic development based, in part, on community needs and interests.
  - b. Recommend to the Town Council goals and objectives relating to economic development.
  - c. Study and review annually the Town's budget allocations for economic development.
  - d. Provide other recommendations to the Town Council as may be requested from time to time.

5. The Economic Development Advisory Board shall be established and operated in the same manner as the other Town Council Advisory Boards, as set forth in Ordinance 3.66, including but not limited to membership, reporting relationships, liaison with Town Council, officers and operating rules, minutes, ~~access to Town staff and the Town attorney, compensation, budget, and reimbursement for expenses.~~
  
6. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Town Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
  
7. Repeal. Existing ordinances or parts of ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this ordinance are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.
