

ORDINANCE NO. 4.24

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES 4.08, 4.10, 4.11, AND APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AND THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO FOR THE OPERATION OF A MUNICIPAL COURT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has previously adopted Ordinances 4.08, 4.10, and 4.11 establishing a Larkspur Municipal Court and modifying the provisions relating thereto, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to establish and maintain a Larkspur Municipal Court and to appoint a Larkspur Municipal Judge and to provide all necessary facilities and personnel relating to such Court and Judge, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur has concluded that the most effective and efficient way for the Town to provide a Larkspur Municipal Court and Larkspur Municipal Judge is to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Town of Castle Rock for such services and personnel.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur has determined that it is in the Town's best interest to authorize future intergovernmental agreements to provide a municipal court system and municipal judge through the adoption of a resolution without the necessity of adopting an ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Ordinances 4.08, 4.10, and 4.11 are hereby repealed in their entirety.
2. A municipal court and municipal court system shall be provided for the Town of Larkspur, Colorado through that certain Intergovernmental Agreement Between the Town of Castle Rock and the Town of Larkspur, Colorado For the Operation of a Municipal Court System ("the IGA"), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
3. The Mayor and Town Clerk of the Town of Larkspur are hereby authorized to execute the IGA on behalf of the Town of Larkspur.
4. In the event the Larkspur Town Council desires to extend the IGA or to replace the IGA with another similar agreement, such extension or replacement may be

accomplished by a resolution duly adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur without the necessity of adopting an ordinance to reflect the Town Council's approval.


5. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Town Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.
6. Repeal. Existing ordinances or parts of ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this ordinance are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.


