

ORDINANCE NO. 5.16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5.01

THIS ORDINANCE HEREBY AMENDS SECTION 2, SUBSECTION A OF ORDINANCE NO. 5.01 PASSED ON THE 21ST DAY OF JANUARY, 1981.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Town of Larkspur, in order to promote orderly development, and to protect and promote the health and safety of its citizens, hereby imposes the following regulations:

Section 2. Utilization of Town Services, subparagraph A is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraphs:

A.1. No septic system shall be constructed within the Town unless previously approved as to design and function by the Town Engineer, the Tri-County District Health Department and the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado.


A.2. No septic system shall be constructed within 100 feet of any potable water line or any existing utility easement which is capable of having constructed within it a potable water line. This determination shall be made by the Town Engineer prior to construction.

Introduced as an ordinance at a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado, on the 1st day of October, 1986, and passed by a vote of 6 for and 0 against, and ordered published.
