

TOWN OF LARKSPUR
ORDINANCE NO. 7.28

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF SUMS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has received Lease money in the amount of \$2,500.00. These revenues were not assured at the time of adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, this income is to be used for the purchase of a water filtration system; and

WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town of Larkspur's Utility Fund;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1

That the 1987 appropriation for Utility Fund is hereby increased from \$184,580.00 to \$187,080.00 for the following purpose: purchase of the water filtration system.
