ORDINANCE NO. 7.29

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE VARIOUS FUNDS AND SPENDING AGENCIES, IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSE AS SET FORTH BELOW, FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, THE 1988 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town Council has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law on November 18, 1987, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has made provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget, and;

WHEREAS, it is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, so as to not impair the operations of the Town.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO:

SECTION 1


That the following sums of money are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for the purposes stated:

	Total Utility Fund	\$103,035.00
