

TOWN OF LARKSPUR
ORDINANCE NO. 7.31

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF SUMS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has received sales tax money in the amount of \$1,200. These revenues were not assured at the time of adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, this income is to be used for equipment purchase; and

WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town of Larkspur's General Fund;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1

That the 1988 appropriation for the General Fund is hereby increased from \$152,042 to \$153,242 for the following purposes: equipment purchase.
