

TOWN OF LARKSPUR  
ORDINANCE NO. 7.33

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE UTILITY FUND TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF SUMS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has incurred additional expenditures in the Utility Fund. These expenditures were unforeseen at the time of the adoption of the budget;

WHEREAS, this income is to be used for water and wastewater system maintenance, salaries and capital improvements; and


WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town of Larkspur's General Fund;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

That the 1988 appropriation from the General Fund to the Utility Fund is hereby increased from \$40,000 to \$110,000 for the following purposes: water and wastewater system maintenance, salaries and capital improvements.
