

TOWN OF LARKSPUR
ORDINANCE NO. 7.34

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO THE UTILITY FUND TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF SUMS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has received grant funds in the amount of \$10,000. These revenues were not assured at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, this income is to be used for capital improvements to the wastewater system; and


WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town of Larkspur's Utility Fund;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1

That the 1988 appropriation for the Utility Fund is hereby increased from \$63,625.00 to \$73,625.00 for the following purposes: wastewater system capital improvements.
