SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES
IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur may receive funds from the proceeds of
a loan in the amount of \$30,000.00. These revenues were not assured
at the time of adoption of the budget, and

WHEREAS, this income is to be used to repay the short term note
authorized by Resolution 89-03; and

WHEREAS, this money is available in the Town of Larkspur's General
Fund;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO,
AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I

That the 1989 appropriation for General Fund is hereby increased from
\$109,250.00 to \$139,250.00 for the repayment of the short term note.


SECTION II

That the 1989 General Fund appropriation for Payroll Expenses be
reduced to \$34,300.00 and the Miscellaneous Expense be increased to
\$6,500.00 for the following purposes: Trash Removal \$2,700.00,
Historical Project \$1,000.00, Town Picnic \$1,500.00, Miscellaneous
\$1300.00


ADOPTED, this 19th day of July, A.D. 1989, passed by a vote of four
