

TOWN OF LARKSPUR
ORDINANCE 7.36

ALL ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE VARIOUS FUNDS AND SPENDING AGENCIES, IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSE AS SET FORTH BELOW, FOR THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO, FOR THE 1990 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town Council as adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget law, on November 13, 1989, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has made provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget, and;

WHEREAS, it is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided by the budget to and for the purposes described below, so as not to impair the operations of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO:

SECTION 1. That the following sums are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for purposes stated:
