ORDINANCE NO. 8.03

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING A PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT  
TO A VOTE OF THE REGISTERED ELECTORS OF THE  
TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO AT THE REGULAR  
ELECTION ON APRIL 3, 1990

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur, Colorado has adopted a Home Rule Charter in accordance with the provisions of Article XX of the Constitution of the State of Colorado, and in accordance with the provisions of Colorado Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council deems it in the best interests of the present and future inhabitants of the Town of Larkspur to submit an amendment to the vote of the registered electors of the Town of Larkspur;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado as follows:

1. The Town Clerk shall, within 30 days of the adoption of this Ordinance, cause notice to be published of an election upon the amendments to the Town Charter contained in this Ordinance, which notice shall contain the full text of the proposed amendments.

2. An election thereon shall be held on April 3, 1990.

3. Notice of the election shall be published not less than 30 days prior to the date the election is to be held.

4. The proposed Charter Amendments are as follows:

(A) A Charter Amendment re-enacting Section 4.01 of Article IV of the Larkspur Town Charter.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR:  
That Section 4.01 of the Town Charter is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

"SECTION 4.01 - THE MAYOR

The Mayor shall be the chief executive and administrative officer of the Town. He shall possess, have and exercise the executive and administrative powers prescribed by this Charter, by ordinance, or by other applicable law."

(B) A Charter Amendment re-enacting Section 4.02 of Article IV of the Larkspur Town Charter.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR:

That Section 4.02 of the Town Charter is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

"SECTION 4.02 - POWERS AND DUTIES

The Mayor shall be responsible for the proper administration of all Town affairs placed in his charge by or under this Charter or by the ordinances of the Town. He shall have the following powers and duties:

- (a) He shall see that the laws and ordinances of the Town are enforced.
- (b) He shall prepare and submit an annual budget and capital program to the Town Council for its approval.
- (c) He shall prepare and submit to the Town Council at the end of each fiscal year a complete report on finances and administrative activities of the Town for such fiscal year.
- (d) He shall prepare and submit to the Town Council a monthly report on finances and administrative activities of the Town for the preceding month.
- (e) Upon request of the Town Council, he shall make reports to the Town Council concerning the affairs of the Town under his supervision.
- (f) He shall advise the Town Council as to the present condition and future needs of the Town and make recommendations to the Town Council to take such actions as he deems advisable, necessary, or expedient.
- (g) He shall exercise supervision and control over the executive and administrative departments of the Town.
- (h) He shall recommend to the Town Council the establishment, consolidation or abolition of Town departments.
- (i) He shall see that all of the terms and conditions imposed in favor of the Town, or its inhabitants, in any contract or franchise, are faithfully kept and performed, and upon knowledge of any violation thereof, he shall report same to the Town Council to consider such action as may be necessary to enforce same.

(j) He shall establish a system of accounting and auditing for the Town which shall reflect, in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, the financial condition and operations of the Town.

(k) He shall make recommendations to the Town Council regarding the hiring, suspension, transfer, or termination of Town employees. The Town Council shall have the power to hire, suspend, transfer or terminate Town employees.

(l) He shall make recommendations to the Town Council regarding the selection and provision of engineering, architectural, maintenance, and construction services for the Town. The Town Council shall have the power to select and provide for engineering, architecture, maintenance, and construction services for the Town.

(m) He shall perform such other duties as may be required by this Charter, by ordinance, or as requested by the Town Council, not inconsistent with this Charter."

Introduced as an ordinance at a special meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Larkspur, Colorado on the 28th day of February, 1990, and passed by a vote of four for, and two against and ordered published.
