



This permit is granted with the explicit understanding that it is the owner's and or contractor responsibility to:

1. Install and maintain erosion and sedimentation control measure in accordance with the Douglas County Storm Drainage Design and Technical Criteria.
2. Revise or modify erosion and sedimentation control measure if it becomes apparent the original plan is adequate.
3. Immediately cease land disturbing activities upon receipt of a written stop work order from an authorized representative of the town. A stop work order will be issued if Permittee is not in compliance with the provision of the approval plan and permittee fails to take corrective action within five (5) days of notification of such non-compliance.
4. Obtain other applicable state and federal permits and approvals, including storm water discharge permits for construction activities issued by the CDPHE-WQCD.
5. Permit is approved for Grading Operations as part of initial phase (Phase 1) only, Approx. 4 Acres. Remaining site development and grading will require subsequent review and approval.
