## NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH UPDATE



### THE SIGNS ARE HERE, THE SIGNS ARE HERE

The Town of Larkspur has received 13 Neighborhood Watch signs. The signs will be erected at the following locations:

1. North end of Town on Spruce Mountain Road
2. South end of Town on Spruce Mountain Road
3. West Town limits on Perry Park Ave
4. Entrance to the New Covenant Church
5. Entrances to north trailhead
6. Entrance to south trailhead
7. Entrance to the trailer park
8. Douglas Blvd at Perry Park Ave
9. Town Hall
10. Town Hall Annex
11. Town Park
12. Upper Lake Gulch Road at Spruce Mountain Road
13. Plum Creek Ave at Spruce Mountain Road

You can purchase a sign for your property. You will be responsible for the cost of the sign; the post and any needed mounting bolts and other supplies. You will also be responsible for erecting the sign on **your** property. Contact Linda Black at Town Hall to get the details on the cost and placement of your sign. The signs must be ordered from and purchased through the Douglas County Sheriff's Office.

The Neighborhood Watch Block Captains are planning meeting in February or March 2019. The date is to be determined, and it will be announced on the Town's social media websites. Everyone is welcome to attend.
