

Kangaroo Motion Sensor program

The Town of Larkspur (Town) applied to the Hey Kangaroo Corporation to participate in their grant funded free Motion Sensor program. The Town's application was approved, and the Town has received 97 free motion sensors.

All Town residents are eligible to participate in this **free** program. You must pick up your motion sensor and apply to the program by April 15, 2019.

The motion sensors will notify you of motion via your cell phone. The motion sensors are a peel and stick product and come with 2 AA batteries.

You can come by Town Hall (8720 Spruce Mountain Road) and see Linda Black to get your sensor. Linda works at Town Hall on Wednesday and Thursday from 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM., or you can schedule an appointment with her by calling 303-681-2324 and ask to speak with her, or by emailing her at lblack@townoflarkspur.org.


6 in 100 households in the USA were burglarized in the last year.
