**ORDINANCE NO. 5.36**

**AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 5.35-IMPOSING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON ISSUANCE OF SEWER TAPS AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF NEW LAND USE APPLICATIONS INVOLVING SEWER SERVICE OR INDIVIDUAL SEPTIC DISPOSAL SYSTEMS (ISDS) DUE TO CAPACITY LIMITATIONS OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT**

**WHEREAS**, On March 7, 2019 the Town of Larkspur passed an emergency Ordinance 5.35 imposing a temporary moratorium on the issuance of sewer taps and the acceptance of new land use applications involving sewer service or individual septic disposal systems (ISDS) due to capacity limitations of the Town of Larkspur's waste water treatment plant.

**WHEREAS**, the Town has since determined the moratorium is no longer needed and therefore motioned to lift the moratorium in a (6) six to (0) zero roll call vote during the Regular Meeting on July 18, 2019.

**WHEREAS**, the Town seeks to formalize the Town Council's motion to lift the moratorium by adopting an ordinance to lift Ordinance 5.35.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Town of Larkspur no longer requires a temporary moratorium as specified in Ordinance 5.35. Said Ordinance is hereby rescinded.
2. The Town Council hereby adopts Ordinance 5.36 to formalize rescind Ordinance 5.35.
